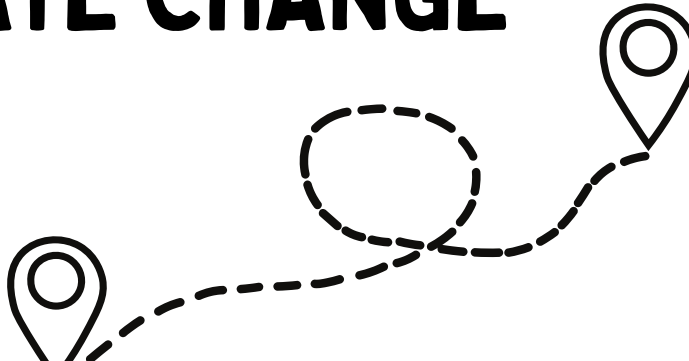


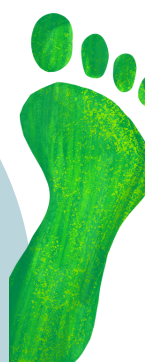


# CORRA'S JOURNEY TO ADDRESS CLIMATE CHANGE

- Engaged with Active travel/ Cycle to work incentives such as the 'Bike2Work' Scheme.

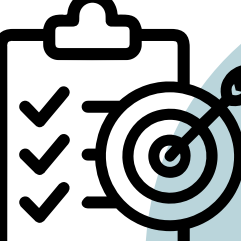
## Funder Commitment on Climate Change
