Pachedu	A charity based in Paisley that runs projects for people from Black, Asian, and Minority Ethnic communities. Funds will support music mentorship for young people with experience of the asylum-seeking process.	£30,600

Paws for Progress CIC	Paws for Progress is a CIC that delivers education, therapeutic, and interactive dog-assisted services for young people who are experiencing barriers to education and support - for example those in prison, those in ASN schools, and others.	£40,800
PUSH (Perth & Kinross) Ltd	PUSH (Perth and Kinross Ltd) supports people with a learning disability or additional support need, to become more included in the community. This is done through an employability programme which is centred around their Reuse charity shop and warehouse.	£24,800

SUNSHINE CLUB	The Sunshine Club provide opportunities and employment for adults with Additional Support Needs in a supportive working environment.	£40,800
The DataKirk	Edinburgh based SCIO providing data literacy and analytics training for young people.	£40,800
THE HOPE PROJECT SCOTLAND	Charity that works with children and their families who live with sickle cell anaemia.	£24,800
The Machan Trust	The Machan Trust is a charity in Larkhall which supports CYP ages 5 - 18. They run breakfast clubs, after school clubs, holiday clubs, family group work including cooking classes and focused work with teenagers who are largely disengaged from school.	£40,800
